- 4. **INTRODUCTION:** The reason for calling this meeting was to ensure that a strategy to attract people to the committee and ensure that the future management of the Lancelin Golf Club remains in good hands by identifying suitable members early in the year. Our AGM is six months away in November, the AGM should not be a meeting that members avoid attending for fear of being Press Ganged into a role that they are:

5. COMMITTEE ROLES & TENURE:

 - 5.4.2. Mentored by current role holder and/or another experienced member.
