Hi Mike

Following my visit yesterday please find below the relevant ratings as requested for the above.

As I suggested in our conversation the calculations definitely saw the course rating increase in difficulty for the reasons I outlined being green surface change, green size change which impacts the calculations of other categories.

I suggest we touch base in six months to see how the below changes have impacted your member handicaps.

Please advise a date that you would like these ratings to be changed and I will update Golfink accordingly.

Please note the following in relation to the ratings and course set up:

- Each rating has been established in accordance with the USGA Course Rating System and were based on the distances and tee markings as provided by yourselves.
- Permanent markers are required to be placed on each teeing ground at the point specific to each course rated.
- Scores must not be handicapped when the length of the course played varies by more than 100 yards (91 metres) from the relevant course rating.

- In order to maintain the playing characteristics of the course and subject to proceeding dot point above, the movable tee markers used to designate the Teeing Ground should not be placed more than 22 yards (20 metres) in front or 22 yards (20 metres) behind the relevant set of permanent markers.
